Numeracy	We are continuing to work in the revision groups set up. Children will be revising a whole range of maths topics which will include solving word problems, properties of shapes, handling data, fractions and decimals. We will continue our practice of all the times tables, every day.
Literacy	We are continuing the revision groups that have been set up. This will enable the children to focus on both reading comprehension and their writing skills. The children will be set a variety of timed writing tasks to allow them to practice writing within a specific time limit. We will also be revising features of a variety of writing- including stories, newspapers, leaflets, diaries, etc.
Science	The main emphasis for science revision this term will be using scientific vocabulary. We will be looking at topics covered, and identifying the correct vocabulary to use. The class will also be doing further practical experiments, using their scientific vocabulary to write good conclusions.
PE	We will be doing a variety of short fitness tasks throughout the weeks leading up to the SAT's. Following the tests we will be focusing on football skills and learning to play as a team.
DT	During the week following the tests, we will be focusing on a design and technology topic of designing and making a soft toy. The children will be creating a variety of designs that they will then choose to make into their own stuffed toy, using felt, scraps of fabric and their sewing skills! The children will be using their own creative ideas to make either a cute and cuddly toy or a horrible and scary toy!
