<b>Numeracy</b>	We will be starting the term by looking at fractions and decimals. The rest of the term will consist of revision of a whole range of topics including percentages, time and interpreting data.
<b>Literacy</b>	We are beginning the term by focusing largely on revision of grammar and punctuation. We will also be writing a news report and a play script. The rest of the term will consist of a revision of genres of writing with an additional emphasis on reading comprehension.
<b>Science</b>	Our science topic this term has begun with learning about microorganisms. The class will proceed to then go onto looking at reversible and irreversible changes.
